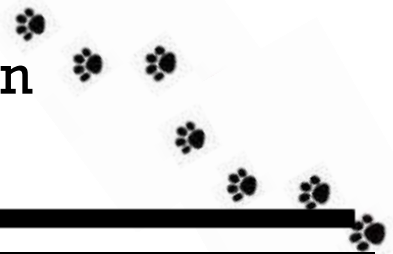

To access Method Test Prep from the student-side:

Log in to [Career Cruising](#) and click **My Plan**.

Scroll down and click the **Method Test Prep** link. The program will open in a new window.

The first time you log in, you'll be asked to enter your email. Email addresses must be entered upon initial entry to accounts.
